## Completed Bakery Project Update The Galloway Foundation

We are delighted to report that with the Galloway Foundation's tremendous support of \$50,000, we were able to complete much needed renovations to Fr. Luc Jolicoeur's bakery and paint all of the primary and secondary classrooms in the school building. Needless to say, Fr. Luc is extremely happy that the repairs and renovations are finished, the students have a beautiful place to learn, and the community is able to reap the benefits of the newly refurbished bakery.

Suffering great damage after the earthquake, *Hope for Haiti* was immediately compelled to do whatever necessary to get Fr. Luc's bakery back up and running. Prior to the earthquake, the bakery worked 24 hours a day and produced over 10,000 loaves daily. Fr. Luc gives the bread to his school, the Little Brothers of the Good Shepherd, the orphanage, and staff, and sells the remaining loaves to his local community at a low cost. The bakery has also provided 300 women with jobs who now can buy bread at a wholesale cost in the morning and sell individual loaves on the street during the day. The bakery has not only provided families with food, but also a source of livelihood. Today, the bakery is not only back to functioning at its original capacity, but it looks and produces better than ever!

The plan for further growth is for Fr. Luc to expand the business through a professional marketing campaign and to work towards hiring someone who is capable of taking the bakery to the next level. Without these repairs and the renovation, Fr. Luc would not be in a position to take this next step. Right now, we are confident that the bakery is helping to take care of the needs of the school and orphanage and is providing the whole community with a reliable source of sustenance.

We are most grateful for The Galloway Foundation's foresight in supporting this project at such a critical time. *Hope for Haiti* continues to be at the forefront of the recovery, rebuilding, and healing of this nation, and we would be honored for the opportunity to continue working on projects such as these in partnership with The Galloway Foundation.
