

## Marre a Coiffe Primary School

Marre a Coiffe Primary School was established in 1963 by a small group of Haitian nuns to be a private rural chapel school for the children living on top of this remote mountaintop. Still today, this private school that is held in the community church is the only one in a one-hour walking radius of the school's location. There is also no secondary school accessible in this area making it very difficult for students to continue their education even if their parents had the funds to do so. Currently, the school has 140 students and 4 teachers.
