

Nursing Home Renovation of Foyer St. Joseph



Foyer St. Joseph D'Aquin was initially built in the 1960's by the Sisters of Charity of St. Louis to provide elderly people living on the streets with a safe place to call home and receive adequate care. After half a century, the facility has long since shown its age and is in desperate need of repair and renovation. More urgently however, the Sisters of Charity of St. Louis lack the funding to "adequately" care for these grandmothers and grandfathers with nutrition, hygiene, and healthcare. Currently they are provided with just one meal a day and no real access to healthcare. **Hope for Haiti** has been working diligently to increase the quality of life for the elderly men and women living at the Foyer through complete facility renovations, food supplementation, medications and supplies, and visits from volunteer medical professionals.
