

St. Antoine Primary School

St. Antoine Primary School has a long history in this rural community. The school was started in 1930 by the community and then later taken on by the Parish of Cote de Fer in 2000. The same building from 1930 still stands and houses grades 5th and 6th although it is in very bad condition after multiple severe storms. There are two buildings in addition to their church that are used for the school (kindergarten-6th grade). The students and the parents have begun to bring local materials such as sand, rocks, and blocks to a piece of land next to the church in hopes to build a real school building in the future. Currently the school has 234 students and 10 dedicated teachers.
