

Tete Source Community Primary School

This year *Hope for Haiti* is partnering with buildOn, an international organization focused on empowering local villages through their own development efforts by building schoolhouses in rural communities. Hope for Haiti has supported Tete Source to provide the financial resources needed to build 6 classrooms. The community built 3 classrooms last year and will finish the remaining 3 classrooms by September 2009. Although *Hope for Haiti* provides the financial resources to buy the supplies needed to build the school, the community is responsible for the construction and for bringing all the raw materials including; rocks, sand, water, and wood.



This school was started in 2000 by Rochel Banatte, who chose to return to his community to start this primary school, knowing that the children of Tete Source had little to no access to an education. The school provides a quality education to 240 students and receives 100% pass rate on their 6th grade national exam each year. *Hope for Haiti* also supports the school's 10 teachers in subsidizing their salaries, relieving the burden placed on families to pay school tuition fees. We are proud to be working with such a dedicated community who values education and who are willing to join together to provide the best they can offer for their children.
